12 Driving Forces is an assessment tool created by TTI Success Insights that measures why a person does what they do. It looks at the motivation (and strength) behind behaviors, using 6 different motivators.

What Does 12 Driving Forces Measure?

12 Driving Forces measures six factors.

- Knowledge (Instinctive and Intellectual)
- Utility (Selfless/Resourceful)
- Surroundings (Objective/Harmonious)
- Others (Intentional/Altruistic)
- *Power* (Collaborative/Commanding)
- Methodologies (Receptive/Structured)

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These 6 motivators are each divided into two distinct sides, list above, measuring each factor. Based on a continuum, these 12 drivers make up a person's cluster of Driving Forces.






What Does the 12 Driving Forces Assessment Do For Individuals and Teams?
